The new building will be finished by the end of February and is already booked for the first weekend in March! It is a very

versatile building as it sleeps 60 people, has a meeting area for up to 150, a nice kitchen, and large front and back porches.

God has provided the funds to move from the completion of Blessed Assurance Dorm right over to building a new Gift Shop. The gift shop will have 2,000 sq. ft. of shopping with a small coffee bar, drink machines, and an 8' covered porch surrounding the building. It will be located in the middle of the camp. This building will be a gathering area that will bless our groups and camps for many years to come.

We are so thankful to the Lord for providing these new facilities at Camp Copass!

Guatemala Mission Trip 2017

Campamento Rio Dulce in Guatemala was a great success this year!

2017 marks the third year that Camp Copass has conducted day camp for the Kekchi people in the Rio Dulce area. Three hundred fifty children and adults from outlying villages came by boat to meet at the campgrounds in a small village in the jungle. The children experienced all the fun of camp, including crafts, recreation, bible studies, and worship. Of course, they were taught the Gospel of Jesus Christ and had opportunity to respond. Thirty one children received Christ this year!

From the beginning of this endeavor, the goal has been not only to have camps in Guatemala, but to teach the people how to conduct camps and to support a ministry. Each year, we try to give more responsibility to the pastors and volunteers in Rio Dulce. The first two years we took eighteen people; this year we took only ten, in hopes that volunteers would step up to fill the gaps. On the first day of

camp, volunteers showed up but lacked the confidence to lead the activities. On the second day, some of the pastors called all of the volunteers together before camp activities started. This was an outstanding turning point and attitudes were visibly changed. After that meeting, they began to organize. Small groups of leaders would meet, brainstorming new ideas for songs and games. They increasingly took on more roles in the assembly and were able to connect to the children culturally in a way that we have not been able to do. The people of Rio Dulce displayed a desire to take ownership in their camp, and showed signs that in the future, they will be capable of running a successful camping ministry in their area.

Camp Copass would like to thank everyone that gave their time, money, and other resources to minister to the beautiful people in Guatemala. The team truly felt the prayer support from all of you. This wonderful work could not have been accomplished without your support.

Giving all effort, glory and honor to Him, while being His light in such a beautiful yet dark place is what we as Christians are all called to do.


Campamento Rio Dulce is a beautifully imperfect place, where imperfect people come together to worship a loving and perfect God.

Summer Staff Needs

Every year Camp Copass hires high school graduates and college students to be part of the staff and help out during the summer months.

Thousands of children and youth visit the camp during this time and our goal is to create an environment conducive to the Holy Spirit working in their lives. Our staffers are not counselors that work directly with the campers; rather our ministry is to serve and take care of the needs of others.

It takes a lot to feed over 700 campers three meals a day, five days a week, so the majority of the time spent is in the dining hall. Some of the other staff jobs include working in the concession stand, cleaning buildings and serving food. On Monday nights, some camps have a carnival which the staff help with; face painting, snow cones, cotton candy, and crazy hairstyles are a few of the activities we provide. We are also looking for

lifeguards and ropes course facilitators. The camp will pay the cost of certification classes for these employees.

Being a summer staffer takes a lot of effort but it is an important part of the ministry. Without us, the campers would not have a clean place to sleep nor food to eat, and the worship leaders would not have a receptive audience to tell them about the love of Jesus. A good attitude and work ethic is a must because the days and weeks are long, especially with the Texas heat. The job is rewarding; many staffers make lifelong friends. There are also opportunities for spiritual growth; every morning as different staffer leads in a short devotion and once a week there is a Bible study. At times the staff enjoys a night when the camp takes everyone out to eat.
