Our staffers are not counselors that work directly with the campers; rather our ministry is **to serve and take care of the needs of others.**

- HELPING WITH NIGHT LIFE EVENTS SUCH AS GAME NIGHT/GLO PARTIES/BAZOOKA BALL, ETC.
